The Transforming Care work is about providing better support and services for children, young people and adults with a learning disability, autism or both who have behaviour that challenges. This also includes those who have mental health problems.



There is a national plan called **Building the Right Support** which is about the work that needs to happen to improve things for people.

This plan is to help the **Transforming Care Partnerships**. These are sometimes called TCPs for short.



Transforming Care Partnerships have been set up across England. They include the NHS, councils, people with a learning disability and autism and their families. They are using the **Building the Right Support** plan to work together to improve local services and support and stop people living in hospitals a long way from home.

This will mean that local services will replace Assessment and Treatment Units as far as possible. Community Learning Disability Teams and new services will help support people to stay in their local community.



A research team are doing work to find out how well Transforming Care Partnerships are making changes to the way that people are being supported. We want to know what has been working well and what still needs to improve.

We want to know if Transforming Care Partnerships are involving people in their work. We want to know about examples of good work that has happened to improve people's lives.
